# (i) Executive Summary

The aim of the research is to identify route to employment, and assess interest in digital-media. 70 S3 students from Tain Royal Academy were given a presentation about: career development, information about the Tain & District Development Trust, and youth engagement proposal. To assess engagement, a 3-part questionnaire was delivered to measure: youth engagement, session satisfaction, and digital-experience. A one-to-one session was also conducted to receive feedback from Tain Royal Academy students.

Results found less than a quarter of students wished to remain in the area for employment, with those opting to leave indication lack of opportunities and career development for reasons to leave. Session evaluated found that either excellent or above average for informativeness and enjoyment; cited as feeling were: curious, inspired and motivated. Instagram, Snapchat and YouTube are channel that students would like to assist with, with graphic design, social media management and vlogging as skills interested in learn.

Recommendations include to develop a program of sessions relating to develop students' employability skills, and to collaborate with Tain Royal Academy and in the community to provide employment opportunities within the area.

A presentation was delivered on the 6th and 7th February to S3 Tain Royal Academy students to outline: my personal career journey, the role of the Tain and District Development Trust within the community, and my research on ways to engage young people in the Highlands.

A 3-part questionnaire was delivered to assess: youth engagement [Appendix A], session satisfaction [Appendix B], and digital-experience [Appendix C].


### One-to-One



A one-to-one session was conducted to receive feedback from Tain Royal Academy students. Previous discussions involved board members approaching students and asking: What would young people like to see more in the community?






Where would you go to study at university?







What business skills do you think are useful to learn?




What do you think can be done to improve opportunities for youth in the Highlands?





How would you rate the usefulness of this session?




How would you rate the amount of new information you learned?




How would you rate the session in terms of meeting your expectations?










Are you planning to take action as a result of attending this session?








Would you be interested in assisting the Tain and District Development Trust



Would you be interested in finding information about qualifications relating to social media?





### 4. Questionnaire Results Overview



#### **Questionnaire One: Youth Engagement**

97% suggested they were interested in attending university- with Maths, English, History, Science, and Engineering ranking as the top options; nearly two-thirds inferred that they would attend university in Scotland. For those interested in apprenticeships- mechanics, engineering, construction and beauty were main interest for students. If students wanted to remain within the area, only 23% suggested they would remain in the area for employment; 81% that opted to leave cited career development, wanting to explore, and lack of opportunities. Communications, problem solving and leadership ranked as the top skills students believed- with more information and work-placement opportunities.

### **Questionnaire Two: Session Evaluation**

87% as either above average or excellent, 80% rated information received as above average or excellent, with 98% enjoying the session overall. The main words that students cited as feeling were: curious, inspired and motivated.

### **Questionnaire Three: Digital Work-based Learning**

97% suggested either yes or maybe interested in working for hub, with 81% interested in finding more information about social media certifications. The channels that students would be interested in helping out with are: Instagram, Snap Chat and YouTube. The digital skills would students be interested in learning are: graphic design, social media management, coding and vlogging.

# 5. What To See in Tain: One-to-One Session Feedback with Tain Royal Academy Students



### YMCA Youth Cafe

As there is a noticeable trend of young people socialising on the streets, event nights aimed at teenagers. There is a consensus the certain age groups feeling missed out, and there is a greater need for more variety [especially for those aged between 14-16].

#### Cinema

Film nights or a place to social/watch films with friends outside of home environment.

### Improved Facilities in the links

Such as food/vending machine or a cafe in the "shed." Additionally, improvement can include: public toilets, cleaner pond, and improve quality of football pitch.

### Teenage Activities

There is a lack of ability for teenagers in the rural villages for socialising. Suggested idea of community mini bus for young people out in the rural community to drive them to social gatherings.

#### Youth Trust Committee

Potential idea of the creation a youth forum within the hub; each year group would present a few students for this initiative.


### More Visibility

In order to improve engagement, the trust/hub needs to be more visible. This can include drop in sessions at the school or help with pse classes. Overall, the feeling is that the trust needs to be more involved with the school.

### 6. Recommendations



From analysing the results, the following recommendations are cited below:





Based upon feedback from students, develop a program off sessions relating to: communications, problem solving and leadership. This will help develop students' employability skills, creative thinking and soft skills required for modern employment.

### **Community Collaboration**



Collaborate between Tain Royal Academy, Tain and District Development Trust, and other relevant providers to develop work-based employability for students in the community. This will involve working with businesses in the community to assist the academy in provider employment opportunities within the area
